J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the County Court Division for the month of March, 1943, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Emile F. Sterger, Clerk, Court of Common Pleas, for the month of March, 1943, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by the City of Tulsa covering Streets and Parks belonging to the City of Tulsa for the years 1931 to 1940, Inc., and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a contract be entered into with Dr. D. W. LeMaster to pay him at the rate of \$125.00 per month and an additional \$75.00 for T.B., subject to the approval of the State Board of Public Health. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
