Petition of Cosden Pipe Line Co. Approved.      Petition of the Cosden Pipe Line Company, for the construction of a system of pipelines, telephone and telegraph lines over, under, across and along the public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, was, upon motion, approved as per petition on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Resignation of O'Farrell Appt. of Allen      Upon motion, the resignation of Mr. P. H. O'Farrell, as Trustee of Jenks Township, was accepted.

Upon motion, W. F. Allen was appointed Trustee of Township of Jenks, to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. P. H. O'Farrell.

Petition of A. B. Patterson Granted.      Upon motion, it is hereby ordered that Mr. A. B. Patterson, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be given permission to change sub-structures for bridges Nos. 114, 115, 116 and 117 from masonry to reinforced concrete, as per plans and specifications prepared by the County Engineer, and on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Upon motion, the County Clerk was instructed to issue the following call to the voters of Tulsa County, Oklahoma:

Call for Election in matter of abolishing Township offices.      To the Legal Voters of Tulsa County, Oklahoma:

You are hereby notified, and notice is hereby given, that at the next general election to be held in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit, on the 3rd day of November, A.D. 1914, the following question will be submitted for the ratification or rejection of the legal voters of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to expend in excess of the \$5,000.00 authorized by law, a total sum not to exceed \$10,000.00, or as much thereof as they deem necessary for the purchase of lands and the improvement of the County Poor Farm?"
