

R E S O L U T I O N .

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma held on the 5th day of July, 1921, the following resolution was introduced by Ed Dalton, who moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, W. W. Stuckey, the retiring County Treasurer of this county has this day filed with this Board his report as by law required, said report has been duly approved by this Board, and

Dickey all securities, bonds and investments now in his possession and held by him for and on behalf of Tulsa County and its municipality.

And the said W. L. Dickey is hereby directed to issue same and deliver to the said W. W. Stuckey his receipt therefor, on proper delivery to him by the said W. W. Stuckey.
