appointing a consulting highway engineer was taken up, but after discussing the matter it was decided to adjourn until Saturday December 1st, 1917, at 2 o'clock P.M.

Saturday, Dec 1st, 1917.

The Board of County Commissioners met with the Advisory Committee in regard to the appointment of a consulting engineer. A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by R.A.Martin that the appointment be postponed until after the inspection of the roadways in the East and after consulting the United States Highway department at Washington. Motion prevailed.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT.

It is agreed between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma as first party and Lon R. Stansberry as second party, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar paid to the first party by the second party, that the said second party may build an outside iron stairway on the south side of the building to be constructed by him, situate on the north thirty (30) feet of Lot 5, Block 149, in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof; and in constructing the landing of said stairway, the second patty may use not to exceed four (4) feet on the North side of the south seventy (70) feet os said lot 5, same being owned by the first party herein. It is further agreed that said stairway shall be built into the wall of the said building belonging to the second party, and shall have under it no support or arches, and shall not touch the soil of the property owned by the first party except that portion thereof upon which said landing of said stairway may rest, not exceeding a space in excess of 4 X 6, and said landing shall be located at least thirty (20) feet East of the West line of said Lot 5, It is also agreed that if the County wants to use their ground for a building then this stairway will have to be moved. It is further agreed that this agreement shall be binding upon the successors, heirs and assigns of the respective parties hereto, and shall continue in force so long as second party shall maintain said stairway in good repair.
