whereas, on this day, December 19th, 1944, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, acting as Ex-Officio Commissioners, and Agents, for Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, there was presented for consideration, execution and approval by the Attorney for said Drainage District, a certain Contract between said District and The Midland Valley Railroad Company, in reference to the construction, location and operation of certain stoplog structures over and across certain portions of said Railway Company's tracks near Garden City, Oklahoma, as more parricularly set out and described in said Contract attached thereto, as a part of the co-operative improve, ment project now being constructed and installed in said Drainage District between said District and the U. S. War Department, to control flood waters of the Arkansas River within said District, And,

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into on this 19th day of December, 1944, by and between Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, acting through the Board of County Commissioners as ex-officio Commissioners for said Drainage District, hereinafter called "District", as first party and

MIDLAND VALLEY RAILROAD COMPANY

hereinafter called "Ownwe", as second party, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, District, in conjunction with the War Department of the United States of American, is now constructing a levee in said Drainage District No. 12 for the protection of certain lands against flood waters of the Arkansas River, and

WHEREAS, in connection with the building of said levee, it is necessary for District to construct certain stoplog structures upon, over and across owner's tracks where the levee crosses the main line, side tracks and belt line tracks at the east and west center line of Section 23, Township 19 North, Rage 12, East, and,

WHEREAS, in the operation of said stoplog structures, it will be necessary for DISTRICT to place temporary obstructions across the said tracks of Owner which will interfere with traffic thereover, and
