Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by J. B. Daniel for the East Side Christian Church covering real estate for the years 1930 to 1932, inc., be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Misc. No. 36790.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the two affidavits of erroneous assessment filed by James E. Wade covering real estate for the years 1931 and 1932, be and the same are hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the John Gunter & Company be permitted to place a native limestone boulder and attached to this boulder will be a ornate bronze marker commemorating the drilling of the first oil well within the State of Oklahoma, on the lawn of the Court House, said location to be selected by the Board of County Commissioners. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by J. J. Henderson, Attorney for Fanny Henderson, requesting a refund of taxes paid, be and the same is hereby denied for the reason that the County Commissioners have no jurisdiction over refunds. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Misc. No. 36794.
