

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Board of County Commissioners request to the City of Tulsa ^{to release} that portion of land lying South of 17th Street and extending to 21st street, between Louisville and New Haven Avenues, covered by a lease dated February 18, 1946, between the Board of County Commissioners and the City of Tulsa. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Board of County Commissioners request the City of Tulsa to release that portion of land approximately 100 ft. wide, along the East Side of Louisville Avenue, lying between 15th and 17th Streets, presently identified by a wire fence separating said strip of land from a tract used by the City for Veterans' Housing, covered by a lease dated February 18, 1946, between the Board of County Commissioners and the City of Tulsa. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Gray, No; Commissioner Greer, yes; Commissioner Bailey, yes. Chairman declared motion carried.
