MONDAY, AUGUST 12th, 1940.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that Sam Omstott be appointed Assistant Building Superintendent as of August 15th, 1940, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Earl Carson. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the report on the condition of two hogs and one beef slaughtered at the Tulsa County Farm, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman, deposited on August 6th, 1940, with the County Treasurer, \$112.60 received from the State Election Board for the primary election. Receipt No. 19918. Same was ordered filed.
