AND, WHEREAS, the above mentioned contract recites that when mutually agreed to by and between the County Board and the Contractor, the contract may be considered for extension to additional work of the same character.

AND, WHEREAS, STANDARD PAVING COMPANY has agreed to pave one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) Mile between Sections 32-33, T 19 N., R 12 E., at the same prices which prevail in the original contract NO. 194, and under the same specifications.

AND, WHEREAS, it is considered to be for the best interest of Tulsa County to accept the above agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Contract No. 194 be and the same is hereby extended to include the above mentioned One Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) Mile of Paving between Sections Thirty Two (32) and Thirty Three (33) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East.
