It is further understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that on all moneys so paid to the County Treasurer of Tulsa Dounty, State of Oklahoma, party of the second part, if he has not been fully compensated prior to the payment of said moneys, must file his claim and substantiate the same by competent and proper proof, within 30 days from the date of such payment.

It is further understood and agreed that a copy of this contract presented by DAN TANKERSLEY, party of the second part, to any official, Board or Commission of the State of Oklahoma, shall be his full and complete authority to appear for and represent the said County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in all matters covered bythe terms hereof.
