

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and un-animously carried, that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pursuant to petition of affected property owners filed with the County Clerk June 26, 1950, does hereby relinquish all right, title or interest the said County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, may have acquired by virtue of a certain Dedication of street as contained in plat to Hall's First Addition to the City of Sand Springs, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being Plat No. 306, filed of record the 21st day of May, 1918, and recorded in the Deed Records in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, insofar as said dedication covers the following described real estate situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

That portion of Broadway Street lying between Block 5, and Block 6, in Hall's First Addition to the City of Sand Springs, being a strip of land 60 feet wide and 140 feet long on Broadway, and just West of Walnut Street, according to the recorded plat of said Addition, and situated in Section 10, Township 19 N. Range 11 E/. Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

which said tract of land has never been used, opened, or accepted by Tulsa County for street or road purposes, and is not needed or required by the County of said purpose;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute and acknowledge this relinquishment in order that it may be recorded in the Deed Records in the office of the County Clerk of said County.
