WHEREAS, it is optional with the Board of County Commissioners as to the diversion of these monies to the county and township Sinking Funds, and

WHEREAS, there was apportioned to Tulsa County for the fiscal year 1939-40 \$254.42 from this source.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in open session this the 20th day of August, 1940, that this money be set up as received from the State in the County Highway Cash Fund instead of apportioned between the county and township Sinking Fund, and the County Clerk is hereby directed to give proper notice by publication of this action.
