Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Mr. C. B. Nedrow be sent to a hospital for treatment of his arm and taken care of by the County doctors without expense to Mr. Nedrow. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that in case of injury to any employee of Tulsa County covered by the Workmen's Compensation Law of the State of Oklahoma; said employee is to be treated and cared for by the physicians and surgeons employed by Tulsa County without cost to Tulsa County or claimant and that the physicians and surgeons employed by Tulsa County be notified of this resolution. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that February 21st, 1938 (WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY), be and the same is hereby declared a legal holiday for the County offices. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the resignation of R. W. Paris, Bailiff of the County Court, be and the same is hereby accepted as of January 31st, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the appointment of Elmer Orr, Bailiff of the County Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, effective as of February 1st, 1938, at a salary of \$100.00 per month, be and the same is hereby confirmed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that an additional \$500.00 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of February, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
