Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the Request of Glenn E. Millard to vacate part of 29th Street lying south of Lot 4, Block 2, Meadow Lane Addition, be and the same is hereby denied, upon the recommendation of the County Engineer.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Order be, and the same is hereby approved:

PIPE LINE ORDER

ORDER BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

Now on this the 29 day of Nov., 1948, the matter of the petion of THE TEXAS COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Delaware, for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said county for hearing, and it appearing that it was just that the said The Texas Company be permitted to use as much of the highway as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description which is as follows, to-wit:

- 1. To cross College Avenue along the North part of Mohawk Blvd., in Lakeview Heights Addition; said Lakeview Heights Addition being in the NE1 of the SE1 of Sec. 17, T 20 N, R 13 E, Tulsa County Oklahoma.
- 2. To cross the blacktop road to the incinerator of the City of Tulsa along the north side of Mohawk Blvd., in the SET of the SWT of Sec. 17, T 20 N, R 13 E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
- 3. To cross 36th Street North along the north side of Mohawk Blvd., between the S_2^{\perp} of the S_2^{\perp} of the S_2^{\perp} of Sec. 17, T 20 N, R 13 E, and the NW $_2^{\perp}$ of the NW $_2^{\perp}$ of Section 20, T 20 N, R 13E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
- 4. To cross Mohawk Blvd., along the southeasterly diagonal line, approximately 275 feet in a northeasterly direction from a point where Mohawk Blvd., crosses the center line of Lewis Avenue, said crossing being in the NW4 of the NW4, Sec. 20, T 20 N, R 13 E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
- 5. To cross Lewis Avenue along the south part of Mohawk Blvd., between Sec. 20, T 20 N, R 13 E, and Sec. 19, T 20 N, R 13 E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways and will be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and permission is hereby granted to said THE TEXAS COMPANY, its successors and assigns to use as much of the highway as above described. Said line to be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and under the supervision of the County Engineer.

The above order does not apply to any State Highway.
