RESOLUTION.

The following resolution was introcuded by F. M. Wooden at a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, On the 18th day of July, 1921, who read the same and moved its adoption, the motion was seconded by Ira Short, and was carried by the Board.

WHEREAS in the Morning adition of the Tulsa Daily World published on the 8th day of July, 1921, the following editorial, to wit: "The declaration of policy made by Mr. George Gilmore, the newly elected chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, is aplended, evincing a conception of public office that squares precisely with the conception of those who created public office. 'So far as I am concerned the County business is to be divorced entirely from political consideration', said Gilmore, 'I take office absolutely under obligation to no living soul, I have made no promises and have no friends to reward or enemies to punish. In the appointments to be made, vote will be cast for the applicants who in my opinion will serve the county best. I have told this to the politicians and am going to make my word good.' Fine indeedlif such a policy is diligently carried out Tulsa County will have cause to Congratulate itself. The petty political
