Cassidy in his service for the month of February at the same compensation as heretofore authorized, be and the same is hereby confirmed. VACATING THAT PARCEL OF GROUND THAT LIES

WHEREAS, there was filed with the County Clerk of this County a petition signed by all parties having any financial interest in Lynn Lane Estates Addition asking that said parcel of ground lying between Blocks 2-3, Lynn Lane Estates Addition be vacated.

AND WHEREAS, said petition was filed on the 24th day of February, 1938, subscribed and sworn to by M. E. Bailey, one of the original owners of Lynn Lane Estates asking that said parcel of ground between Blocks 2-3 Lynn Lane Estates Addition be vacated

AND WHEREAS, said parcel of ground has no benefit to the traveling public of Tulsa County and if said street be retained as part of the highway system of Tulsa County it would be necessary to construct a bridge across a draw at the Southerly portion of said Blocks 2-3, Lynn Lane Estates Addition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is deemed to the best interests of Tulsa County and the citizenship of Tulsa County that said parcel of ground be vacated insofar as any rights, titles, interests or equities are concerned to Tulsa County,
