MONDAY, DECEMBER 6, 1948

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 O'clock A. M., with all members present: Claude W. Bailey, Chairman; Roy Evans and John Couch, Members. William P. Gable, Jr., County Clerk.

Claude W. Bailey, Chairman, presiding, the following official business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the Builder's Contract and Performance Bond, between Robert Marshall, Contractor, and the Board of County Commissioners, covering the building of partitions in the second room on the west side from the south end of the building of the W. T. Vernon School, Bixby, Okla., which Contract and Bond are filed of record, be and the same are hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that Jessie Benningfield be, and she is hereby appointed as Negro Nurse at the Tulsa County Clinic, replacing Celia Wilson, at a salary of \$130.00 per month, effective December 1, 1948.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the resignation of Dr. Joseph Salamy as assistant County Physician, as of November 30, 1948, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that Dr. L. C. Presson be, and he is hereby appointed as Assistant County Physician, as of December 1, 1948.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that Hazel G. Dickason be, and she is hereby approved as a Deputy in the office of the County Treasurer, effective December 1, 1948, at a salary of \$190.00 per month.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the resignation of Charles L. Miller, Jr., as Deputy Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, as of December 1, 1948, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that James M. Lee be, and he is hereby approved as Deputy Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, as of December 1, 1948, at a salary of \$175.00 per month.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the Bond of James M. Lee, in the amount of \$1,000.00, issued by the Western Surety Company be, and the same is hereby approved.
