## GENTLEMEN:

The undersigned, having examined the location of the work proposed, the character of the work and materials to be performed and used, the plans and specifications governing the construction thereof, proposes to furnish all labor and materials, equipment, etc., and to construct strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications (Oklahoma Standard) a bridge proposed to be constructed over Hominy Creek, near the corner of Sections 7-12, 13-18, Township 21 North, Ranges 12 and 13 East, Tulsa County Oklahoma, at the following prices to-wit: based on the approximate estimate of quantities as follows, to-wit:

Independent of the above estimate of quantities, we agree to furnish all materials labor, and equipment and to complete the proposed bridge strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications, for the lump sum of \$26,700.00; and in event there should be any deductions or additions to the structure from that shown in detail by the plans, then, and in such event the above bid unit price shall govern in settlement for both additions and deductions. Certified Check (Bidders Bond) amounting to \$2670.00 is hereto attached, and in event award of contract is made to us, we agree to immediately furnish satisfactory Surety Company Bond, both contract and statutory in the full amount of the contract price and to enter into contract, agreeing to complete the entire structure on or before the first day of March, 1924, and upon failure to do so, we agree that the sum of \$10.00 per day for each day thereafter that the work remains uncompleted may be deducted from the contract price.
