WE HEREBY request the Tulsa County Excise Board to amend or change the Financial Statement and Estimate of needs by reducing the surplus and increasing the claims and contracts pending in accordance with the statement, which would result in reducing the appropriations of Tulsa County in the amount of \$217.41 and we, therefore, request the Tulsa County Excise Board to reduce the amount appropriated for Charity Account Q-3-Y, Garden Projects.
