In the Northeast (NE/4) Quarter of the Southeast (SE/4) Quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian, being 80 feet in width, the center line being described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east section line of said Section Thirteen (13), and 1,710 feet north of the southeast corner of the Southeast (SE/4) Quarter thereof; thence west 167 feet; thence on a curve to the left, having a radius of 1,280 feet, a distance of 332.86 feet; thence south 75°03' west to the west line of the East (E/2) Half of the East (E/2) Half of the Southeast (SE/4) Quarter of said section, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,

for the reason that said portion of said county road was erroneously and unintentionally included in said description in said vacation order of May 3, 1943, and it is necessary to modify said order because the vacation thereof interferes with the War program incident to the construction of the Modification Center No. 16, and it appearing that such request is proper in view of the War emergency.

IT IS, THEREFORE, considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the aforesaid Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the order of May 3, 1943, vacating a certain county road in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more fully described in said order, be and the same is hereby modified and adjudged to be of no force and effect insofar as that portion of said county highway hereinabove described is affected, and that said portion of said road be and is hereby reinstated to its former status of a county road.

IT IS FURTHER considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Chairman of said Board, and grant to said Chairman, the power to execute any necessary instruments which may be required to vacate said order and re-establish said portion of said County road.
