G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

The following bids were received for drugs for the Tulsa County Clinic:

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the bid submitted by Wm. Penn Drug Store in the amount of \$3,793.28, same being the lowest complete bid, be accepted for drugs for the Tulsa County Clinic. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the motion made on August 5th, 1940, requiring Dr. J. Jeff Billington, County Jail Physician, to furnish a \$10,000 bond and the same is hereby rescinded, and that the amount of the bond now be set at \$5,000. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the bond filed by Dr. J. Jeff Billington, County Jail Physician, in the amount of \$5,000 and written by the Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company, be and the same is hereby approved.
