

MONDAY, AUGUST 26th, 1940.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

The minutes of August 21st and 22nd were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that they stand approved as read. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that the resolution adopted on July 1st, 1940, re a one mill extra levy for the purpose of constructing public buildings, be rescinded and that sixty-five one hundredths of a mill be made for the purpose of constructing public building. Mr. Shepard: Let the record show that the motion was not seconded because we want to investigate and see what part of the one mill will be needed.
