A RESOLUTION AND ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CALLING OF AN ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING UPON THE QUESTION OF ISSUING NEGOTIABLE CUPON BONDS OF DAWSON TOWNSHIP, TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS BY PERMANENTLY BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTING SAID ROADS IN SAID TOWNSHIP, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF THE STATUTES AND CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, deem it advisable to permanently improve certain roads in said township, and

WHEREAS, the estimate amount necessary for such purpose is \$250,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are no funds in the treasury ^{for} of such purpose, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners are authorized and empowered by Section 26, Article 10, of the Constitution, and Article 1, Chapter 73, of the Revised Laws of Oklahoma, 1910, and laws ammendatory and supplementary thereto, to issue bonds for the purpose above stated in an amount not to exceed, including the outstanding indebtedness of said township, five (5%) per cent of the taxable property of said township as shown by
