G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Mr. Morley: I move that the motion I made yesterday, August 26th regarding
the one mill extra levy for the purpose of building public buildings be withdrawn for the
reason that if the case is appealed to the Board of Tax Review they have the power to do anything
they want to do with it and to pass on the legality of it and for that reason I want to withdraw
my motion.

Motion by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the
bond filed by J. W. Condreay in the amount of \$1,000, be and the same is hereby approved.
Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye.
Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that a
recess be taken until Friday, August 30th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. All
members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
