the last assessment for State and County purposes: and

WHEREAS, such amount is not in excess of said limit: NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of Tulsa County State of Oklahoma

SECTION I

That the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, do hereby call an election, and the same is hereby called, to be held on the 6th day of September, 1921, in said Township, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said township the following proposition:

"Shall Dawson Township, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, incur and indebtedness by issuing its negotiable cupon bonds in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the purpose of providing funds for the improvement of roads by permanently building and constructing said roads in said township in accordance with the provisions of the statutes and constitution of the State of Oklahoma, and levy and collect an annual tax upon all the taxable property in said township in addition to allthe other taxes subficient to pay the interest on and the printipal of said bonds when due; said bonds to draw interest at the rate of not to exceed six (6%) per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and to mature in twenty five (25) equal installments, the first of which shall be payable one (1) year from the date thereof, and the last of which shall be payable twenty-five (25) years from the date thereof."

SECTION II.

The number and location of said roads to be improved as above set forth, shall be as follows:

ROAD #1. Beginning at a point on Lewis Avenue of the City of Tulsa, just north of the St. Louis and San Francisco Railway right-of-way in Section 32; township 20 north, Range 13, East, thence in amortheasterly direction paralleling the said right-of-way, on the public highway to the east line of Section 28, township 20 North, Range 13 East.

ROAD #2. Beginning at a point on the East Line of Main Street in the town of Dawson, in Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 13 East, thence East two blocks on the main traveled highway for a distance of approximately 600 feet, thence north on the public three blocks or for a distance of approximately 900 feet, thence east on the public highway to the east section line of Section 26, Township 20 North, Range 13 East, thence north on the public highway to the northwest corner of said section 26, thence East on the public highway to the southeast corner of section 24, township 20 north, range 13 east, on the Tulsa-Collinsville State Highway.

ROAD #3. Beginning at a point on the Tulsa-Skiatook State Highway at or near the northeast corner of Section 25, Township 20 north, Range 12 East, thence west on the public highway to the northwest corner of said Section 25, thence south on the Public Highway to the Southwest corner of said section 25, and thence west on the public highway to Main Street of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

ROAD #4. Beginning at a point where Lansing Avenue intersects the north line of Section 36, 76 whip 20 north, Range 12 East, and running south on the public highway to the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION III.

The County Clerk shall be and he is hereby, authorized to cause to be posted in ten (10) of the most public places in said township written notices of such election, such notices to be signed by the Chairman of the Board, attested by the Clerk, with the seal of said county affixed thereto, and shall set out the date and purpose of the election, the place at which said election shall be held, the names of the judges, clerk
