Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Seneca Coal & Coke Company, a Corporation, be released from its previous obligation incurred in May, 1942, on restoring Section Line between Tulsa and Wagoner Counties, and, in lieu thereof, giving Tulsa and Wagoner Counties, jointly, a hard surfaced road approximately one hundred (100) yards to the East. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The hearing on the Petition presented by the Seneca Coal & Coke Company, a Corporation, concerning the relocation and re-establishment of a road in Boles Township, was continued until Monday, January 15, 1945.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the following Resolution be adopted, and the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to execute same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

RESOLUTION TO VACATE, ALTER, CHANGE, LAY OUT
OPEN, RELOCATED AND RE-ESTABLISH PUBLIC ROAD.

Now, on this the 2nd day of January A. D. 1945, there is presented to and comes on for hearing by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in meeting assembled as below set forth, the petition of more than twelve resident freeholders and legal voters of Boles and Willow Springs Townships, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, residing in the vicinity of the road affected, and more than twelve resident freeholders and legal voters of Lone Star and Shahan Townships, Wagoner County, Oklahoma, residing in the vicinity of the road affected, to vacate, alter, change, lay out, open, relocate and re-establish a public road in said Townships, now partly in
