The following Resolution was adopted by the Board.

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in regular session assembled, at the court house in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on this to wit: the 6th day of July, 1909, that Tulsa County, is without a site, without a court house, and without a jail, that an urgent need exists for the purchase of a site and the construction of a court house and jail, for said County, that the probable cost of said site, court house and jail would be \$225,000⁰⁰.

And be it further resolved that said county of Tulsa, is without a poor farm and without a poor house, in which to care for its poor: That said county of Tulsa has a large number of poor and indigent to care for: That the probable cost, to said county of Tulsa, of a poor farm and poor house would be \$25,000⁰⁰.

And be it further resolved that the Board being desirous of encouraging and promoting the improvement of the roads throughout said County, and the formation of Road Improvement Districts therein for that purpose, That Twenty Five per cent of the cost of improving any road within any such District shall be born by the County; That to meet the County's portion of the expense of improving roads in Road Improvement District hereinafter legally created within such County, would be approximately \$400,000⁰⁰.

Be it therefore resolved by the Board that the following propositions be submitted to the qualified and legal voters of Tulsa County, Oklahoma at a special election to be called for that purpose to wit:

First shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to expend the sum of \$225,000⁰⁰, for the purchase of a site and the construction of a Court house in and for said County.

Second: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to issue the negotiable Coupon Bonds of said County, to the amount of \$200,000⁰⁰ to provide the necessary funds for the purchase of a site and the construction of a Court house in and for said county and levy and collect an annual tax upon all taxable property in said county, in addition to all other taxes
