 Sixth: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to issue the negotiable coupon Bonds of said County to the amount of \$25,000. to provide the necessary funds for the purchase of said Poor Farm for said County, and levy and collect an annual tax upon all taxable property in said County, in addition to all other taxes, sufficient to pay the interest on and the principal of said Bonds when due?
 Seventh: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Tulsa, be authorized to expend the sum of \$400,000.00 for the purpose of meeting the County's portion of the cost of improving Road Improvement Districts hereinafter legally created in said County?
 Eighth: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to issue the negotiable Coupon Bonds of said County to the amount of \$400,000.00 for the purpose of raising funds with which to meet the County's portion of the costs of improving roads in Road Improvement Districts hereinafter legally created within said County, and levy and collect an annual tax upon all taxable property in said County, in addition to all other taxes sufficient to pay the interest on and the principal of said Bonds when due.
