In the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation asking permission to lay pipe line, the following Orders were made:

O R D E R

Now, on this the 17th. day of Sept. 1928, the matter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line, under, through and across certain highways in said County and State came before the Board of Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows:

Beginning at a point near the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, Twp. 20 North, Range 13 East; and running thence East to a point near the NW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 23, Twp. 20 N., R 13 E., thereby crossing the North and South Section line highway between Sections 22 and 23, Twp 20, R 13 E., together with any other public roads or highways that may be crossed by a gas pipe line laid according to blue print map of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line known as "Service Line City of Tulsa" a proposed six (6) inch gas pipe line.

And, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
