D. 1914, the question of whether or not the township organization of Tulsa County should be abolished and all of the duties heretofore preformed by the township officers with respect to the townships should be performed by the officers of the county who have like duties to perform with reference to the county at large that the township officers have to perform with reference to the towship, and,

WHEREAS, The result of the vote upon said proposition has been certified to the county clerk of Tulsa, County, Oklahoma by the Secretary of the County Election Board; and,

WHEREAS, Haid certificate shows that there were 2818 cast for said proposition, and 2095 votes cast against said proposition.

NOW THEREFORE, by reason of said election and the vote cast thereon, I Cyrus . Avery, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, do hereby declare that the township officers of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, have been, by virtue of said vote on said proposition and the certificate of same by the Secretary of the County Election Board to the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, abolished, and that on and after January, 1915, the township organization of Tulsa County, Oklahoma will cease; and that thereafter the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, will assume and perform all duties with reference to the township heretofore performed by the township officers.
