In consideration of the sum of \$65.00 in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, does hereby release any and all claims of every nature that they now have or may hereafter have against Theodore Bahos and Ted Bahos, arising out of a collision between a Chevrolet truck driven by Ted Bahos and a Ford sedan owned by Tulsa County and driven by Hugh Sanders, which collision occurred on Saturday, October 4, 1941, in the 2600 block on South Peoria Ave., in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the County acknowledges full and complete satisfaction of all damages of any and every nature arising out of said collision, and forever releases the said Theodore Bahos and Ted Bahos from any liability whatsoever arising out of said collision.
