

## O R D E R

NOW, on this the 17th. day of September, 1928, the matter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in sand County and State, came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners tjereof that it was just that said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows:, to-wit:

Beginning at a point near the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 10, .  
Twp 19 North, Range 13 E., thence running South to a point in  
S ec. 15, Twp 19, North, Range 13, East; thereby crossing the East  
and West Section line highway between Sections 10 and 15, Twp 19  
North, Range 13 East, together with any other public roads or  
highways that may be crossed by a gas pipe line laid in accordance  
with blue print map of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof.  
This line known as "Service Line City of Tulsa", a proposed two (2)  
inch gas pipe line.

AND, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use od said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

## - O R D E R -

WHEREAS, The Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to J LACY BALLENGER of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Fifty and 54/100 Dollars (\$50.54) the following described lts:

Lots 9 and 10, Block 2, Rosemont  
Heights Addition to Tulsa.

AND, WHEREAS, the sale of said lots by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax re-sale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other persons having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lots, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lots for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treas. to J LACY BALLENGER for a consideration of \$50.54, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to him a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.
