

Sixth, It is further mutually agreed that said Road bonds, as above described, shall be delivered to said party of the second part on or before November 1st, 1909, unless otherwise mutually agreed, and that in the event party of the first part cannot, for any reason, issue said Road bonds on or before said date, that each of the parties hereto shall release the other from liability because of said non delivery, and this provision shall also apply to the 25,000 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Poor Farm bonds.

It being understood that the party of the second part shall have the privilege of taking up any or all of said bonds sooner if he so desires.

Seventh. The party of the second part further agrees that he will direct the league proceedings to be had by the party of the first part necessary to authorize the issuance of said Court House, Jail & Bridge bonds, and in addition thereto will furnish and direct the proceedings with reference to the other bonds above described, provided it is ascertained that the said Road & Poor Farm bonds can be issued under the law in the manner desired and contemplated by the party of the first part.
