Avery, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim and declare that said proposition was carried by a majority of the legal votes cast at the last general election held in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and that by reason thereof, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma has been duly and legally authorized to expend said sum in the manner aforesaid, as submitted in the proposition above referred to, to the legal voters of Tulsa, County, Oklahoma.
