WHEREAS, The Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to F B DeSHON of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Seventy Five (\$75.00) Dollars the following described Lot:

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lot, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lot for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.
