

MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE MINUTES
THURSDAY, JUNE 11, 1987

The Board of County Commissioners met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Melvin C. Rice, Chairman; John Selph, Member. Members absent: Lewis Harris. Others present: Clayton Edwards; Janice Lintelman; George Phillips; Wayne Carr; Jim Crawley; Marshall Stewart.

Melvin C. Rice, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., and the following business was transacted:

In a discussion concerning the status of the Jenks Golf Course, Mr. Phillips requested the Board to pass a resolution approving the application to drill water wells for the new course. In addition, Mr. Phillips said a letter from the City of Tulsa, as property owner, would be needed for the application. Edwards was directed to work with the District Attorney's office to draft the resolution for the June 22 agenda. Edwards also is to contact the City of Tulsa.

Selph reported that the bonds for the new course are expected to be sold during the week of June 15.

Regarding warning signs for LaFortune and Chandler Parks, Edwards and Phillips are to work with the District Attorney's office to determine if the nature trail signs at Chandler are in conflict with the suggested warning signs.
