On motion of Board. The Arkansas Valley State Bank's Bid was accepted and County Treasurer was instructed to place \$10000⁰⁰ of County's Funds in said Bank for a period of 6 months. On motion of Board Bank of Tulsa was authorized to make depository and that county funds may be placed therein. On motion of Board Drainage Dist. No. 1 was named Dry district. The appointment of J. G. Mote as a member of the Board of County Examiners was on motion of Board approved. The following Resolutions were taken up and adopted.

Be it Remembered, That at a regular adjourned session of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, in the state of Oklahoma, held at the court house in the city of Tulsa, in said county and state, on the 10th day of August A.D. 1909, convened at the hour of 9 A.M., the following commissioners were present:

Whereupon Commissioner C. H. Cleveland introduced a resolution and order entitled, "A resolution and order, providing for the calling and holding of an election in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 12th day of Oct. A.D., 1909, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters thereof the several propositions of the said county, expending the sum of \$200,000⁰⁰ and issuing its negotiable coupons in said amount, for the construction of a court house in and for said county, and of expending the sum of 25,000⁰⁰ and issuing its negotiable coupon bonds in said amount for the construction of and the purchase of a site for a jail in and for said county; and of levying and collecting an annual tax upon all the taxable property in said county, in addition to all other taxes, sufficient to pay the interest and principal of said court house and jail bonds when due." which resolution was read in full by the clerk.

Now by C. H. Cleveland seconded by George Mc Kahan, that said resolution and order be adopted and passed as read.

The question being put to a vote, the roll was called, with the following results:
