WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to The City of Tulsa of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of One and No/100 dollars (\$1.00) the following described lots:
