

AND, WHEREAS, The County Treasurer has certified to this board that there is a balance of cash in the bond account and maintenance account as of June 30th, 1925 of \$2,942.40; and that that part of said \$2,942.40 representing the maintenance account to-wit: The sum of \$2,468.28 was not used as revenue for maintenance purposes for the current fiscal year.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized as shown by his certificate to use said sum of \$2,942.40, the same being the surplus of cash as above set forth for the purpose of retiring said outstanding bonds.

R E S O L U T I O N.
