John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of H. E. Bloomer, Superintendent of the Tulsa County Farm and Home, be and the same is hereby accepted as of March 31st, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of S. W. Campbell, Superintendent of the Tulsa County Garage, be and the same is hereby accepted as of March 31st, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins; seconded by Commissioner Gray, that S. W. Campbell be appointed Superintendent of the Tulsa County Farm and Home as of April 1st, 1938, at a salary of \$150.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Jack Sulsar be appointed Superintendent of the Tulsa County Garage as of April 1st, 1938, at a salary of \$175.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
