TUESDAY, JANUARY 3rd, 1939.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, January 3rd, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by Andy Stokes, County Clerk, for the month of December, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the official bond filed by James P. Melone/^{County Judge,} in the amount of \$3,000 and made by the Central Surety and Insurance Corporation, for a term of two years from the 2nd day of January, 1939, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the official bond of Andy Stokes, County Clerk, in the amount of \$5,000 and made by the Continental Casualty Company, for a term beginning January 2nd, 1939 and ending January 4th, 1941, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the official bond of A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, in the amount of \$10,000 and made by the Continental Casualty Company, for a term beginning January 2nd, 1939 and ending January 4th, 1941, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the official bond of Cal Crum, Court Clerk, in the amount of \$5,000 and made by the Continental Casualty Company, for a term beginning January 2nd, 1939 and ending January 4th, 1941, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
