

A resolution and order for calling election

of petition for court house.

Said resolution and order, so adopted and passed, is in the words and figures as follows:

A resolution and order providing for the calling and holding of an election in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 12 day of Oct. A.D., 1909, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters thereof the several propositions of the said county, expending the sum of  $\$200,000^{\circ}$ , and issuing its negotiable coupon bonds in said amount for the construction of a Court house and the purchase of a site therefor, in and for said county, and of expending the sum of  $\$25,000^{\circ}$  and issuing its negotiable coupon bonds in said amount for the construction of a jail and the purchase of a site therefor, in and for said county, and of levying and collecting an annual tax upon all the taxable property in said county, in addition to all other taxes, sufficient to pay the interest on and principal of said court house and jail bonds when due."

Whereas, there has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, two petitions with 1096 signatures and 1096 signatures, respectively, which petitions, save for the signatures, are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

Sirs:

We, the undersigned, qualified voters and tax payers of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereby respectfully show that said County has no court house adequate for the needs of the county, and it is the sense of your petitioners that an urgent need exists for the construction of a suitable court house and the purchase of a site therefor in and for said county. Your petitioners are advised from tentative plans and estimates prepared for the purpose that the estimated cost of constructing such court house and the purchase of a site therefor would be  $\$200,000^{\circ}$ .

Your petitioners therefore pray that an election be called and held in said county, at which time shall be submitted to popular vote, the following propositions:

First: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to expend the sum of  $\$200,000^{\circ}$  for the purchase of a site for and constructing thereon a court house in and for said county?

Second: Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be authorized to issue the negotiable coupon bonds of said county, to the amount of  $\$200,000^{\circ}$  to provide the necessary funds for the construction of a court house and the purchase of a site therefor, in and for said county, and levy and collect an annual tax upon all of the taxable property in said county, in addition to all other taxes, sufficient to pay the interest on and principal of said bonds when due?

All as in such case by statute made and provided.
