WHEREAS it appears to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the granting of permission to Water Improvement District No. 5 to take up and lay pipe lines as petitioned for and for the purposes mentioned would be well and proper.

IT IS RESOLVED that said petition be granted, conditioned that said pipe lines be laid to a depth sufficiently below the permanent grade line of said highways and will, if in the future, the location of said pipe line should be in the way of the further improvement of said highways, lower the same upon the request and due notice of any proper authority in charge of said highways; further, that Water Improvement District No. 5 will properly restore the said highways to their former condition as the said pipe line construction progresses and shall save the County of Tulsa from any and all costs and damages of whatsoever character or nature.
