Bridges as Secretary of the Fair Board for one year at the same salary \$300.00 per month, for full time services, plus 5¢ per mile for transportation and expenses, outside of the City of Tulsa, when authorized by the Board, free house rent, the Administration building, lights, water and gas, be and the same is hereby confirmed.
