Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the time of Mr. Boyer, Chief Engineer of the Oklahoma Power & Water Co., in connection with the construction work on their water line be allowed, in addition to the 15% which the Company has been paid, over and above their direct charges. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the Contract between the Board of County Commissioners and the <u>Public Service Company</u> of Oklahoma, covering electric energy for the operation of electrical equipment in the Tulsa County Court House for a period of one year from September 16, 1944, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
