Pursuant to adjournment/in the office of the County Clerk, all members present,
the following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ira Short that the Affidavit of Erroneous Assessment of Pete Ampariotis on the WhiteStar Cleaning and Pressing Shop, be reconsidered by the Board of County Commissioners, and that the same be stricken from record in accordance with the opinion of the County Attorney. All members voting in the affirmative, the same was by the Chairman declared carried.

A motion was made by Ira Short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the Affidavit of Erroneous assessment of Able Teel on 1920 assessment of Lot 1 Block 13, Park View be reconsidered, and that the same be and it is hereby ordered stricken as petitioned. All members voting for the said motion, the same was by the Chairman declared carried.

A motion was made by Ira Short and seconded by Geo. E. Gilmore that the County Clerk be instructed to notify S. C. Maxey and H. J. Gray, Justices of the Peace, to vacate the quarters now occupied by said justices in the basement of the Tulsa County Court House on or before September 1st, 1921. The vote thereon was as follows:

Gilmore that all matters before the Board of County Commissioners be signed by the Chairman of the Board, and that in the absence of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners that a temporary chairman be selected to act in the absence of said chairman in compliance with the law. The vote thereon was as follows:
