"The Section line between sections 19-30, 20-29, and that part of the Section line between 28-29, North of the St.L.& S F Railroad not already designated as County Highway; being 2¼ miles in Township 20 N., R 14 E., from Rushville to Garnett" be designated as a County Highway.
