And the County Clerk is directed to issue Certificates of Error covering same, provided, however, that the Certificates of Error shall not be issued until the expiration of twenty days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said Certificates of Error shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said twenty days until the issue of said protest is determined. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

John H. Miller, Chairman, deposited on March 17th, 1938, with the County Treasurer, \$6.00 collected from Mrs. R. R. Gwin for Water, Gas and Electricity in connection with the lunch counter in the basement. Receipt No. 17526. Same was ordered filed. Also receipt for \$114.00 collected from the operation of the colored municipal hospital. Receipt No. 17529. Same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following persons, to-wit: J. R. Nicholson and J. R. Jones, be and they are hereby employed to assist the retiring Superintendent of the County Farm to check out his affairs and turn the same over to the newly appointed Superintendent; said above named persons are to receive the sum of \$10.00 per day each for every day <sup>actually</sup> engaged in the performance of the services and said per diem to be charged to the expense of the County Farm. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Miller, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that D. L. Morse be appointed in the Highway Department at a salary of \$100.00 per month, said salary to be paid from the regular payroll, and effective as of March 1st, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
