The polls of said election will be opened at the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon and closed at the hour of six o'clock in the afternoon of said election day, except in the city of Tulsa the polls will be opened at the hour of six o'clock in the forenoon and closed at the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon.

That said election will be conducted in the manner prescribed by the general election laws of the state of Oklahoma; and all persons possessing the qualifications prescribed by said law and by the constitution of said state are entitled to vote at said election.

That said election proclamation and notice shall be, and the same is hereby ordered published in two weekly newspapers published at the County seat of said county, and of general circulation in said county, for four consecutive calendar weeks, the first of said publications to be not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date fixed for said election.

Section 3 That the ballots for said election shall set forth the propositions to be voted upon substantially in the forms heretofore mentioned; and the same shall be prepared, the said election held as conducted, the votes cast thereof counted, and the results thereof returned, canvassed and certified, as and in the manner prescribed by the general election laws of the state of Oklahoma.

Section 4 That this order and resolution, together with the proceedings of the Board relative thereto, shall be published in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published and of general circulation in said Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Section 5 That the County Clerk be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Election Board of said Tulsa County, at the end of thirty (30) days from its adoption and passage.

Section 6 That this resolution and order shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption and passage.
