Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the following Resolution be adopted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of September, 1941, owners of land originally assessed in the Parkview Drainage District of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, filed a statement with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, setting forth the necessity of making a tax levy for the purpose of repairing and cleaning out the drains and ditches in said drainage district, and

WHEREAS, thereafter the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, ordered and directed the drainage commissioner of said drainage district to make an estimate of the amount necessary to be expended in repairing and cleaning out said drainage ditches, and

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of September, 1941, J. M. Baker, Drainage Commissioner of the Parkview Drainage District, filed his estimate in which he set forth that it is necessary that the sum of \$8,000.00 be expended to repair and clean out the drainage ditches, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, fixed the day of hearing upon said report at this day and this hour, and

WHEREAS, notice thereof was given as required by law, and

WHEREAS, no protests have been filed to the report of said drainage commissioner, and no one has appeared to contest said report in any way, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, finds that said report should be approved and the amount set forth in said report of said drainage commissioner is by the Board of County Commissioners found to be reasonable in amount.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED that the report of said drainage commissioner be in all things approved, and it is ordered that a tax levy to raise the sum of \$8,000.00 be assessed against the property of said drainage district, pro rata, according to the original assessment of benefits; and the County Assessor is ordered to place the same upon the tax books of the County against the lands and crops, rents and profits of said drainage district to be collected as taxes.
